ALSA FORUM

The Asian Law Students' Association's hallmark event, the annual forum, together all ALSA members from different nations for a range of academic and extracurricular activities. More significantly, the yearly General Assembly, offline Governing Council Meetings, and international board elections will take place at the start of ALSA's office term.

ALSA CONFERENCE

Another international gathering place for our members to get together and work toward making ALSA a significant student-run organization is the annual conference. This event offers participants the chance to expand their networks, develop their academic knowledge, gain insight into the legal system of the host nation, and participate in intellectual and cultural exchanges.

ALSA INTERNATIONAL MOOT COURT COMPETITION (AIMCC)

The ALSA International Moot Court Competition is a simulated arbitration proceeding that simulates an international investment dispute settlement. Students from around the globe will submit their Written Memorials for the complainant and respondent of a fictional case that has been written by professionals. Selected teams will present their memorials for the complainant and the respondent in front of a Panel of Arbitrators in the Oral Round following the Written Round (Memorials). The competition will provide participants with the opportunity to enhance their analytical skills, legal research, writing, and advocacy abilities, as well as to expand their understanding of and exposure to international law issues in the simulated environment of an international court or arbitral tribunal. The competition fosters the exchange of ideas and perspectives on contemporary legal issues, promotes networking among law students, and, as a result, expands the development of the law. The experiences gained from the AIMCC are carried over into later life, influencing successful careers in various fields of legal practice.

ALSA INTERNATIONAL MEDIATION COMPETITION (AIMC)

The ALSA International Mediation Competition is a mechanism for fostering, encouraging, and disseminating the use of mediation among newer generations of professionals who are committed to the effective resolution of disputes. ALSA is of the opinion that AIMC will provide students with varying academic backgrounds and levels of training the opportunity to improve their mediation abilities in a global context. AIMC is an educational event that encourages the open interchange of ideas, experience, and knowledge between students from diverse backgrounds, cultures, generations, and countries. It also aims to promote the effective use of mediation. All participants are expected to demonstrate respect and appreciation for cultural diversity. The primary objective of AIMC is to effectively integrate the Mediator's skills and collaborative problem-solving abilities in order to effectively communicate the Parties' interests and progress toward resolution. ALSA aspires to equip the legal professionals and businesspeople of the future with the necessary skills to effectively address the dispute resolution requirements of a global and increasingly cross-cultural marketplace.

Rapat Pimpinan Nasional (Rapimnas)

Pra-Musyawarah Nasional & ALSA Leadership Training (PALT)

ALSA National Conference

ALSA National Conference merupakan salah satu acara tahunan ALSA Indonesia. Terdapat 3 (tiga) rangkaian utama dalam acara ini, yakni seminar, round table discussion, brainstorming, dan workshop. Materi seminar tentunya di bidang hukum, disampaikan oleh orang-orang yang mumpuni di bidang dan/atau keilmuannya dengan tema yang bervariasi setiap tahunnya. Saat workshop, peserta nantinya dapat berlatih bagaimana berpraktik sebagai praktisi hukum, seperti halnya melakukan due diligence, membuat kontrak, melakukan simulasi negosiasi, dan sebagainya. Rangkaian acara terakhir adalah City & Culinary Trip berfungsi sebagai wadah untuk meningkatkan keakraban para peserta sekaligus juga mengenalkan budaya dan wisata daerah tuan rumah penyelenggara Seminar dan Workshop Nasional.

ALSA National Moot Court Competition (NMCC) Piala Mahkamah Agung RI

Kompetisi Peradilan Semu Pidana Tingkat Nasional ALSA National Chapter Indonesia adalah kompetisi peradilan semu antar fakultas hukum perguruan tinggi se-Indonesia dalam lingkup kasus pidana yang diselenggarakan oleh National Chapter bersama Local Chapter tuan rumah. Sebagai Lomba Peradilan Semu tertua dan paling bergengsi, membuat kompetisi ini sangat diminati oleh berbagai universitas di Indonesia, dengan jumlah peserta 16 tim juga dari seluruh universitas di Indonesia.

Seminar dan Musyawarah Nasional (Semunas)

Seminar dan Musyawarah Nasional (Semunas) adalah Acara Nasional dan forum tertinggi ALSA Indonesia. Acara Nasional ini diadakan setahun sekali di akhir kepengurusan National Board ALSA Indonesia guna menandakan pergantian kepengurusan. Terdapat 2 (dua) agenda penting didalam Semunas yaitu Seminar Nasional dan Musyawarah Nasional. Seminar Nasional diselenggarakan guna membahas suatu isu hukum yang sedang hangat diperbincangkan di tengah masyarakat serta mencari suatu solusi terhadap permasalahan dengan cara interaksi dua arah antara pembicara dengan peserta seminar. Sedangkan Musyawarah Nasional (Munas) merupakan forum musyawarah tertinggi di dalam National Chapter dimana agenda pembahasan di dalamnya telah dibicarakan terlebih dahulu di dalam Pra-Musyawarah Nasional.

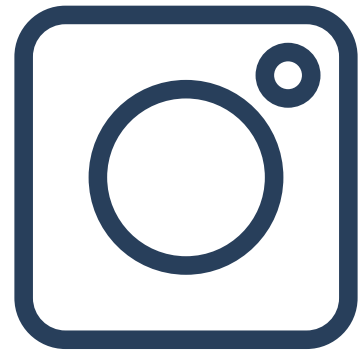
