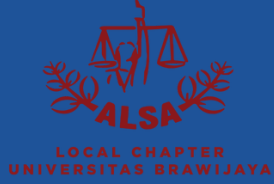

What is ALSA?

Asian Law Students' Association (ALSA) is a non-profit, non-political organization that aims to connect law students from the corners of Asia. As an organization that includes 17 National Chapters, ALSA has been a melting pot for various cultures throughout Asia since its establishment over 30 years ago. With the number of National Chapters that joined ALSA, the organization has connected around 12.000 students Asia-wide.

ALSA has become and continually improves as a premier association that provides the venue for bright law students to develop as future leaders and major players in Asia that welcomes cultural diversity and advances the professionalism and hard-working ethic that are an evident characteristics of Asians.



History Of ALSA

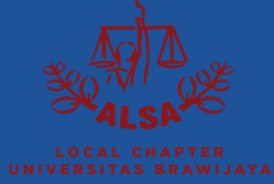


ASEAN Law Students' Association was formed in 1989 by a group of Indonesian law students who had an idea to form an organization where they can promote a better understanding and appreciation of different legal systems in each country, as well as promote friendship among the students. ASEAN Law Students Association's members are Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore, and Thailand.

On September 7th, 2002, ALSA and the other Asian Countries unified in the Asian Law Students' Association (ALSA) by **Tokyo Agreement**. Now, ALSA has **17 National Chapters**.

ALSA National Chapter Indonesia is a full and founding member of ALSA. Founded in 1989, ALSA National Chapter Indonesia is divided into **15 Local Chapters** of various universities and spread to 5 islands from the west to east of Indonesia.

ALSA LC UB is part of ALSA Indonesia's National Chapter which is located in the Faculty of Law Universitas Brawijaya Malang, East Java. ALSA LC UB was officially established as a Local Chapter by the first National Assembly in Jogjakarta in 1993, completed by Universitas Brawijaya's Rector Decree on **October 13th, 1994**.



History Of ALSA Indonesia



On September 21 – 24, 1987, the National Assembly of the **Senate Association was held by Indonesian Law Students (ISMAHI)** in **Makassar**. The newly elected ISMAHI leader at that time sparked the thought that it was important for law students to have an understanding of the different legal systems in ASEAN countries. Then, the idea was discussed at the ISMAHI National Working Plan Session in Denpasar in 1988. At that time, ISMAHI realized that it was very important to build an understanding among ASEAN countries in the field of law.

Based on this background, they decided to create a forum in the form of the **ASEAN Law Students Conference (ALSC)**. The conference was held on 15 – 20 May 1989 in **Jakarta** by inviting law students from several ASEAN countries to attend ALSC supported by the ASEAN Secretariat, ASEAN Legal Association (ALA), Asia Foundation, the Government of Indonesia, and Governments of ASEAN Countries.
